The Malaysian ICT Week 2004, which was held from 2nd - 5th of September 2004 at the Mines Exhibition and Convention Centre in Seri Kembangan, Selangor, drew more than 14,000 visitors, the event organiser said. Themed "ICT for All", the four-day event featured three main expos under one roof: the Asean Communications and Multimedia (ACM) Expo & Forum 2004, the Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) Expo 2004, and the National E-Commerce Expo Week (NECE) 2004.

A total of 330 exhibitors from 28 countries were participating in what is billed as the biggest ICT event in Malaysia. It showcased the latest technologies, solutions and services for the Government, corporate enterprises, small- and medium-sized industries (SMIs) and home users, organiser AMB Exhibitions Sdn Bhd president Tan Sri Dr Ahmad Mustaffa Babjee told a press conference yesterday. Major exhibitors include the Telekom group, Maxis, DiGi, Time dotCom, Sapura, Astro, Fujitsu, Jaring and Motorola.

A slew of new technologies and services were unveiled at the ACM Expo, including a humanoid robot, high-speed mobile network, 128K smart SIM for mobile and 3G services. The MSC Expo showcased the success of the MSC Flagship Applications spearheaded by the Multimedia Development Corp (MDC).
